GAMING GUIDE

How to play 4-Card Poker.

4-Card Poker is played with a standard 52-card deck. The game features head-to-head play against the Dealer with an optional side bet.

Ante wager (player vs. Dealer)

The object of the game when playing against the Dealer is for the Player to form a 4-card poker hand higher or equal to the rank in the Dealer's 4-card poker hand. Players use their four of five cards dealt, whereas the Dealer uses the best four out of six cards dealt. To play against the Dealer, you must make an ANTE wager. After being dealt a hand of five cards face down you can:

- a. Fold (forfeit) your hand and ANTE wager.
- b. Continue playing by placing a play wager in an amount at least equal to the ANTE and up to three times the ANTE. The ANTE wins 1 to 1. Player wins all ties.

Automatic bonuses

Players who place an ANTE wager and a PLAY wager win an Automatic Bonus for the following premium hands:

4 of a Kind	25 to 1
Straight Flush	20 to 1
3 of a Kind	2 to 1

Automatic Bonuses are paid even if the Dealer has a better 4-card hand.

Aces up wager (player vs payable)

A Player may place an optional ACES UP side bet to win an additional payout based on the Player's best 4-card poker hand. If the Player's hand contains a pair of Aces or better, the Player wins the ACES UP wager. Players can bet the ACES UP wager with or without an Ante wager.

Aces up pay table

4 of a Kind	50 to 1
Straight Flush	40 to 1
3 of a Kind	8 to 1
Flush	5 to 1
Straight	4 to 1
2 Pair	3 to 1
Pair of Aces	1 to 1

The ACES UP wager is paid even if the Dealer has a better hand. When a Player bets both the ACES UP and the ANTE (including PLAY) wager, each wager is settled separately.

Ante - Object is to get a 4-card hand that beats the Dealer's best 4-card hand.

Aces up - Object is to get a pair of Aces or better. If a Player has placed an ANTE wager and an ACES UP wager but does not want to make a PLAY wager, the Player shall forfeit the ANTE wager but not the ACES UP wager.

Progressive wager

A Player may make a \$1 Progressive wager to win from the Progressive Pay Table. Progressive Wager is based on the player's final 5-Card hand NOT the 4-Card hand.

Progressive pay table

Royal Flush:	100% of Mega	Envy Bonus: \$1000
Straight Flush:	100% of Major	Envy Bonus: \$300
4 of a Kind:	100% of Minor	--
Full House:	\$50	--
Flush:	\$40	--
Straight:	\$30	--
3 of a Kind:	\$9	--

A Player must make an Ante wager to bet the \$1 Progressive. Any Player betting a progressive wager also qualifies for an Envy Bonus. The Player with the winning hand will be paid the amount associated with the hand but does not qualify for the Envy Bonus.

All Ante, Aces Up and Progressive wagers must be placed prior to the dealer announcing "No more bets."

If a hand does not contain a pair of better, the hand that contains the highest ranking card(s) wins. Ace is the highest ranking card, except in 4-3-2-Ace sequence.

All Players must remain seated during a round of play.
